



2008 Hurricane Decal Information

June 1st began Hurricane Season therefore prompting the need to obtain hurricane decals. Residents that live south of the Intra-coastal canal that were issued decals in 2007 will not need to purchase them for the 2008 Hurricane Season. If you do not have a decal you can purchase them at Gulf Shores City Hall from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The cost is \$10.00.

Strict proof of residency or property ownership will be required in order to purchase decals. Proof may be in the form of a deed, lease, utility bill, driver's license, etc. Any document with the physical address of the property will be sufficient.

Please be mindful that under Section 7 of City of Gulf Shores Resolution No. 4033-06, *“once a hurricane warning has been issued, NO hurricane passes of any kind will be available until after the storm”*

Again, if you already have red decal from last year they are good for 2008. The red decal also serves as a beach parking pass for the summer 2008 season.
